Important information

Health, GPs, and Hospitals

Emergencies

Call 999 immediately if an ambulance is required. Give the address “**Newark Showground, Drove Lane, Winthorpe, Newark NG24 2NY**”, and alert the first aid team (see below). Stewards will ensure the ambulance can find you.

24/7 First Aid

During the day, first aid cover will be given by the Newark Community First Aid. We have our own qualified first aiders (wearing **green HEFF t-shirts**) available at all other times. Both of these groups can assist with accidents or sudden medical emergency:

- For both teams of First Aiders call: **07387-191738** or ask a crew member to radio for assistance
- Depending on the nature of the incident, the first aiders will either come to you or ask you to meet them at the first aid point as instructed
- Our first aiders are not qualified to give advice on, or treatment for, general medical issues. If you need such advice call NHS 111 or arrange to see a GP.

A&E (Accidents & Emergencies)

There are two hospitals with 24 hour A&E, and two with urgent care units, all about a 35 minutes drive from the site, depending on traffic.

Safety on site

We want everyone to have a fun time and to be safe during the event. We have to have a limited number of rules in place to make this so:

Parental Supervision

Everyone aged under 18 on the site must have a named and contactable adult (over 21) responsible for them, and that adult must provide a level of supervision which is appropriate to the child's age and maturity at all times. The adult must be sleeping on the site, and be present on site when the child is on site during the day. If you are responsible for a child who is old enough to be apart from you please ensure that your phone and your child/ren's phones are charged and can be used to contact each other at ALL times. There are sockets available in marquees and in the Pavilion. It's also parent/guardian responsibility to check, with Workshop Leader, if adult supervision is needed at the start of kids' workshops.

Traffic

Speed limit on site is 5 mph (that's walking speed!).

No vehicles may move on the site during the hours of darkness, and vehicle gates will be secured.

There will be unrestricted vehicle access to the car park on the southern runway, and pedestrian access to the site. Vehicles must not be reversed at any time without a responsible adult looking out behind.

We cannot guarantee that if you park your car by your tent you will be able to move it again before the end of the event. The camping area will be quite full and it may get blocked in. Vehicles must not be parked on roads inside the site.

We strongly recommend that, after you have unloaded, you take your car to the car park.

Site Evacuation

In the unlikely event of an evacuation of the site, vehicles must not be moved. Follow the crew directions to move to a safe location on foot. Do not re-enter the site or evacuated area until you are told it is safe to do so.

Fires and Barbecues

Fires and barbecues which are OFF THE GROUND are permitted; please do not scorch the grass, and please use common sense. Never leave a smouldering barbecue on a tent porch or close to the tent. Carbon Monoxide can kill silently.

Smoking

If you smoke, please take extreme care not to start a fire or leave litter and please be considerate of others around you. You must not smoke inside any building or marquee, nor within 5 metres of an entrance to one.

Drugs

No illegal substances may be brought on to the site. Anyone in possession of drugs will be asked to leave immediately and the police may be informed. Parents please ensure that older children are aware of this. For the sake of our community please do not put future events at risk.

Alcohol

There will be no alcohol for sale on the site. You are reminded that it is a serious criminal offence to supply alcohol to anyone under the age of 18.

Our crew will return any young person considered at risk to the care of their responsible adult, or call the adult to come and take responsibility for their welfare.

Bullying

As an organisation we do not accept bullying. Everyone should feel safe at our events. While we do not want to be involved in every little dispute, please bring any concerns of a serious nature to the attention of the crew or board members.

Safeguarding

Flying Items

No drones, model aircraft or sky lanterns to be used on site.

Dogs

Dogs must be on a lead, and any mess cleared up immediately.

Water

Do not waste water or allow your children to do so. Taps must not be left running. Washing up must not be done at the drinking water taps

Marquees and Other Equipment

Marquees, guy ropes, and poles are not safe to play or climb on, and must not be used for sticking up signs. If you want to put up a sign or a poster, please talk to crew members at the event office to find a suitable place.

Health & Hygiene

Rubbish skip & recycling

There will be a large rubbish skip available for rubbish disposal near the Red Gate site entrance.

On-site separation of recyclables is not necessary, as the rubbish processing plant will do so after collection of the skips.

Recyclable items, bottles, cans, paper and card, glass, plastic containers should **NOT** be bagged and placed loose in the skip.

Food and foul or non recyclable waste must be bagged.

Toilets

The toilets are being cleaned by the HEFF crew, please respect them by

minimising litter and mess in the toilets and contact the festival office or a crew member with a radio if there are any issues.

To avoid blockages and consequent queues, do not flush anything that you have not eaten! The only exception is a reasonable amount of soft toilet paper

Please make our task easier by using the bins provided.

Showers

There are male and female showers in the toilet block at Red Gate, and one accessible shower pod just outside the building, which is reserved for those with an accessibility need. All showers are free to use for festival visitors:

- There may be queues early in the day. Please consider using showers in the afternoon or evening
- Wherever possible, please limit time in the shower to 10 minutes
- Don't leave your toiletries and toothbrushes behind in the shower.

Stomach bugs and hygiene

Fortunately, our last few festivals were pretty much free of stomach bugs. To avoid spreading disease we would ask you:

- Not to do anything which might contaminate the water points
- Not to wash out any toilet related items at the taps (There is a dedicated Elsan disposal point on the right hand side of the toilet block at Red Gate)
- All dog mess must be bagged immediately and taken to the rubbish skip. It must not be disposed of in any other way
- We will be providing a small freezer for you to refreeze cooling blocks to help you keep food fresh and cool at your tents. **This is for cooling blocks only.** It will be in the entrance hall of the Cedric Ford Pavilion and only accessible when it is open (if anyone has a

larger one they would like to donate or lend for next year, please let us know!)

- Please do not wash your pots and pans in the sinks inside the toilet block, there is a washing up station provided near Red Gate Toilets

COVID-19

The HEFF Board have adopted the following on the subject of COVID-19 which is in accordance with Government guidance at the time of writing:

“We are not required by law to take any preventative measures related to COVID-19. We ask that any family where someone has potential COVID-19 symptoms before arriving does not attend and applies for a ticket refund. If anyone develops symptoms during the event, they are requested to leave and go home as quickly as possible. We will be taking some basic additional hygiene measures, such as providing hand sanitizer, enhanced cleaning of touch points in the toilets, and only accepting card payments in the office. The wearing of masks is a matter of choice for individuals.”

Weather

English summer is known to be fierce at times - it just can't make up its mind! Remember to stay hydrated to prevent heat stroke, pack and apply sunblock as required and ensure children are suitably protected.

We have a safety plan in the case of a thunderstorm passing overhead. Please comply with crew instructions.

Noise

Whilst the Newark Showground is less sensitive as far as noise spilling off the site is concerned than some other sites, we still ask that you respect your fellow campers and don't use amplified music or percussion in the camping areas at night, and keep conversations at a reasonable level.

Quiet zone

Special rules apply in the quiet zone, please keep this area as quiet as possible after dark.

Photography & Filming

Bridget is our official photographer and will be taking photographs around the site. She will have a crew badge. If you are concerned and do not want your child photographed, please speak to her. If we use a photograph in social media of you or your child that you are uncomfortable with, please let us know and we will happily remove it.

The festival office is now relocated in a marquee just inside the entrance to the Main Ring. This has a couple of advantages, one of the main ones being that it is more accessible to all.

All enquiries related to the festival running, bookings, and merchandise sales, will be handled by the office. Lost property will be kept here, as well as “found” children who need to be reclaimed. If you “lose” a child and become concerned, this is also the place to report that, though you may also approach any member of the crew for assistance.
