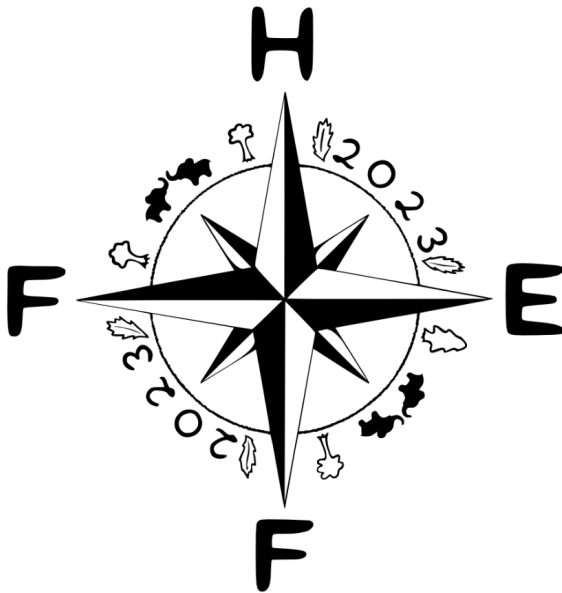

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# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

## **Safety on site**

We want everyone to have a fun time and to be safe during the event. We have to have a limited number of rules in place to make this so: Please ensure you familiarise yourself with the essential information below.

## **Parental Supervision**

Everyone aged under 18 on the site must have a named and contactable adult (over 21) responsible for them, and that adult must provide a level of supervision which is appropriate to the child's age and maturity **at all times**. The adult must be on the site throughout the period that the child is on site and should be contactable via phone in case of any emergency. If you are responsible for a child who is old enough to be apart from you, please ensure that your phone and your child/ren's phones are charged and can be used to contact each other at ALL times (there are numerous sockets available in the main building, workshop areas and the games room for charging phones).

It would be especially useful if a parent's/guardian's telephone number was displayed on younger children's wristbands, as it is not unknown for younger children to get confused or separated on site. This will make it easier for us to reunite a missing child with their parents.

It is also the parent/guardian responsibility to check, with the Workshop Leader, if adult supervision is needed at the start of each workshop.

## **Traffic**

Speed limit on site is 5 mph (that's walking speed). No vehicles may move on the site during the hours of darkness, and the vehicular access gates will be locked between dusk and 9am.

There will be unrestricted vehicle access to vehicles in the car park to the west of the Showground (i.e. on the opposite side of the road to the Showground main entrance), therefore if you are likely to need 24 hour access to your vehicle, it would be wise to park it there. It is linked to the Showground via a walkway under the main road. Vehicles that remain on

site must not be reversed at any time without a responsible adult looking out behind.

We cannot guarantee that if you park your car by your tent you will be able to move it again before the end of the event. The camping area will be quite full and it may get blocked in. Vehicles must not be parked directly adjacent to roads inside the site.

**We strongly recommend that, after you have unloaded, you take your car to the car park opposite the Showground (as described above).**

### **Electric Vehicle Charging**

There is an electric vehicle charging point on the site. To ensure that this can be available to all who may potentially need it, you are asked to move your vehicle from the vicinity when it has completed its charge. Whilst your car is charging, please display either your mobile number or HEFF booking reference. This is in case we have to ask you to move.

### **Site Evacuation**

In the unlikely event of an evacuation of the site, vehicles must not be moved. Follow the crew directions to move to a safe location on foot. Do not re-enter the site or evacuated area until you are told it is safe to do so.

### **Fires and Barbecues**

Fires and barbecues which are OFF THE GROUND and only intended for cooking purposes, are permitted. Please do not scorch the grass and please use common sense. Never leave a smouldering barbecue in a tent porch or close to the tent. Carbon Monoxide can kill silently.

### **Smoking**

If you smoke, please take extreme care not to start a fire or leave litter and please be considerate of others around you. You must neither smoke inside any building on the Showground nor within 5 metres of any entrance to one

## **Drugs**

No illegal substances may be brought on to the site. Anyone in possession of drugs will be asked to leave immediately and the police may be informed. Parents please ensure that older children are aware of this. For the sake of our community please do not put future events at risk.

## **Alcohol**

There will be no alcohol for sale on the site. You are reminded that it is a serious criminal offence to supply alcohol to anyone under the age of 18. Our crew will return any young person considered at risk to the care of their responsible adult, or call the adult to come and take responsibility for their welfare.

## **Bullying**

As an organisation we do not accept bullying. Everyone should feel safe at our events. While we do not want to be involved in every little dispute, please bring any concerns of a serious nature to the attention of the crew or Board members.

## **Safeguarding**

## **Showground Facilities**

**We would request that you treat all facilities at the Showground with respect. In addition to this, there are a few areas which are out of bounds and therefore nobody should be accessing the following areas:**

- The Main Ring (except during scheduled activities)
- The Grandstand
- Bingley Hall (excluding, shop, showers, first aid and toilets)



- The model railway area
- The building near the railway that is a club area
- We are using all the other areas of the Showground for workshops and other events.

## **Equipment and Facilities**

Please be mindful that we are guests on Staffordshire Showground and ask that you respect all the facilities in an appropriate way. Please do not in any way tamper with or damage any fixtures or fittings; if you discover damage, please let crew or Board members know immediately.

If you want to put up a sign or a poster, please talk to crew members at the event office to find a suitable place.

## **Flying Items**

No drones, model aircraft or sky lanterns to be used on site.

## **Dogs**

Dogs must be on a lead at all times, and any mess cleared up immediately and disposed of in the skips provided. The area to the south of the main Showground should be used for dog walking. This is accessible via a footpath which runs beside the Games Hall.

## **Water**

Do not waste water or allow your children to do so. Taps must not be left running. Washing up must not be done at the drinking water taps; there is one permanent dedicated area for washing of dishes at the toilet block on the northern side of the site, and another beside the Games Hall.

## **Health & Hygiene**

### **Rubbish**

There will be large bins available for rubbish disposal located near the entrance to the Prestwood building. We would ask that all food and foul waste be bagged.

## **Toilets**

The toilets are being cleaned by the HEFF crew, please respect them by minimising litter and mess in the toilets and contact the festival office or a crew member with a radio if there are any issues.

It would be really helpful to everyone if you could leave toilets and communal areas as clean as you can. Please make our task easier by using the bins provided for any non flushable waste.

## **Showers**

There are male and female showers at the entrance to Bingley Hall. There is an accessible shower in Zone H of the camping area, which is reserved for those with an accessibility need. All showers are free to use for festival visitors:

- Wherever possible, please limit time in the shower to 10 minutes
- Please clear all of your belongings when you finish in the shower.

## **Stomach bugs and hygiene**

Fortunately, our last few festivals were pretty much free of stomach bugs. To avoid spreading disease we would ask you:

- Not to do anything which might contaminate the water points
- Not to wash out any toilet related items at the taps; there are dedicated Elsan disposal points adjacent to the toilet block to the north of the site and next to the Margaret Everton Pavilion.
- All dog mess must be bagged immediately and taken to the rubbish bins. It must not be disposed of in any other way
- Please do not wash your pots and pans in the sinks inside the toilet block, use the permanent washing up stations

## **Freezer Blocks**

If you need to refreeze freezer blocks, we have a system in place whereby this can be done by leaving your blocks in a plastic bag labelled with your

name for easy identification inside the Grandstand Café by 12 noon each day. These will then be frozen and taken out of the freezer at 12 noon the following day. The café is doing this as a favour to us without charge. Please respect these timings and don't ask them to exchange blocks at other times as they can only open the freezer a limited number of times.

## **Weather**

English summer is known to be fierce at times - it just can't make up its mind. Remember to stay hydrated to prevent heat stroke, pack and apply sunblock as required and ensure children are suitably protected.

We have a safety plan in the case of a thunderstorm passing overhead. Please comply with crew instructions.

## **Noise**

Whilst the Staffordshire Showground is less sensitive as far as noise spilling off the site is concerned than some other sites, we still ask that you respect your fellow campers and don't use amplified music or percussion in the camping areas at night, and keep conversations at a reasonable level.

## **Quiet zone**

Special rules apply in the quiet zone, which is on the extreme north of the Showground. Please keep this area as quiet as possible, especially after dark.

## **Photography & Filming**

Unfortunately Bridget, our official photographer, is unwell and unable to attend this year. Paul Bendall has very kindly offered to take her place and will be taking photographs around the site which can be used to publicise future events. All photos and videos will be property of HEFF. Paul will have a crew badge. If you are concerned and do not want yourself or your child photographed, please speak to him. If we use a photograph in social media of you or your child that you are uncomfortable with, please let us know and we will happily remove it.

## **Festival Office**

Festival office enquiries should be raised at the reception desk near the Ingestre Suite.

All enquiries related to the festival running, bookings, and merchandise sales will be handled from this desk. Lost property will be kept here, as well as “found” children who need to be reclaimed. If you “lose” a child and become concerned, these are also the places to report that, though you may also approach any member of the crew for assistance.

## **Health, GPs and Hospitals**

### **Emergencies**

Call 999 immediately if an ambulance is required. Give the address “**Staffordshire Showground, Weston Road, Stafford ST18 0BD**”, and alert the first aid team (see below). Stewards will ensure the ambulance can find you.

### **24/7 First Aid**

We have our own qualified first aiders (wearing **green HEFF t-shirts**) available 24 hours a day throughout the festival. They can assist with accidents or a sudden medical emergency. Our first aid point will be located (signposted on the map at the back of this booklet) at the front of the Bingley Hall.

For our team of first aiders call: **07774 080 297** or ask a crew member to radio for assistance. Depending on the nature of the incident, the first aiders will either come to you or ask you to meet them at the first aid point.

Our first aiders are not qualified to give advice on, or treatment for, general medical issues. If you need such advice call NHS 111 or arrange to see a GP.

### **A&E (Accidents & Emergencies)**

There are two hospitals with 24 hour A&E about 35 minutes’ drive, and during the day there is one with an urgent care unit about 5 minutes from the site (timings dependent on traffic).

We have a great selection of workshops, conferences, sports, shows, live bands, DJs and so on. It is full on. There is a lot for everyone to enjoy. Some may find it useful to plan ahead as to which workshops you would like to attend. We have major events highlighted in **bold** and we have tried to minimise crossovers at these times.

Some workshops are repeated and some are continuation/daily from previous ones (like yoga). However, with the silk printing, you will need to attend sessions 1 & 2 to complete your project. The workshop will run

twice during the festival, so you will need to attend a 'session 1' and a 'session 2' for relevant continuity.

We respectfully ask that everyone chips in and helps with the setting up (if asked by the workshop leader) and tidying up at the end of a workshop. It just makes for a nice communal feel.

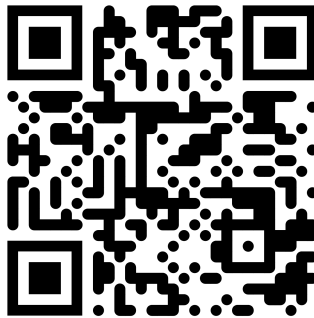

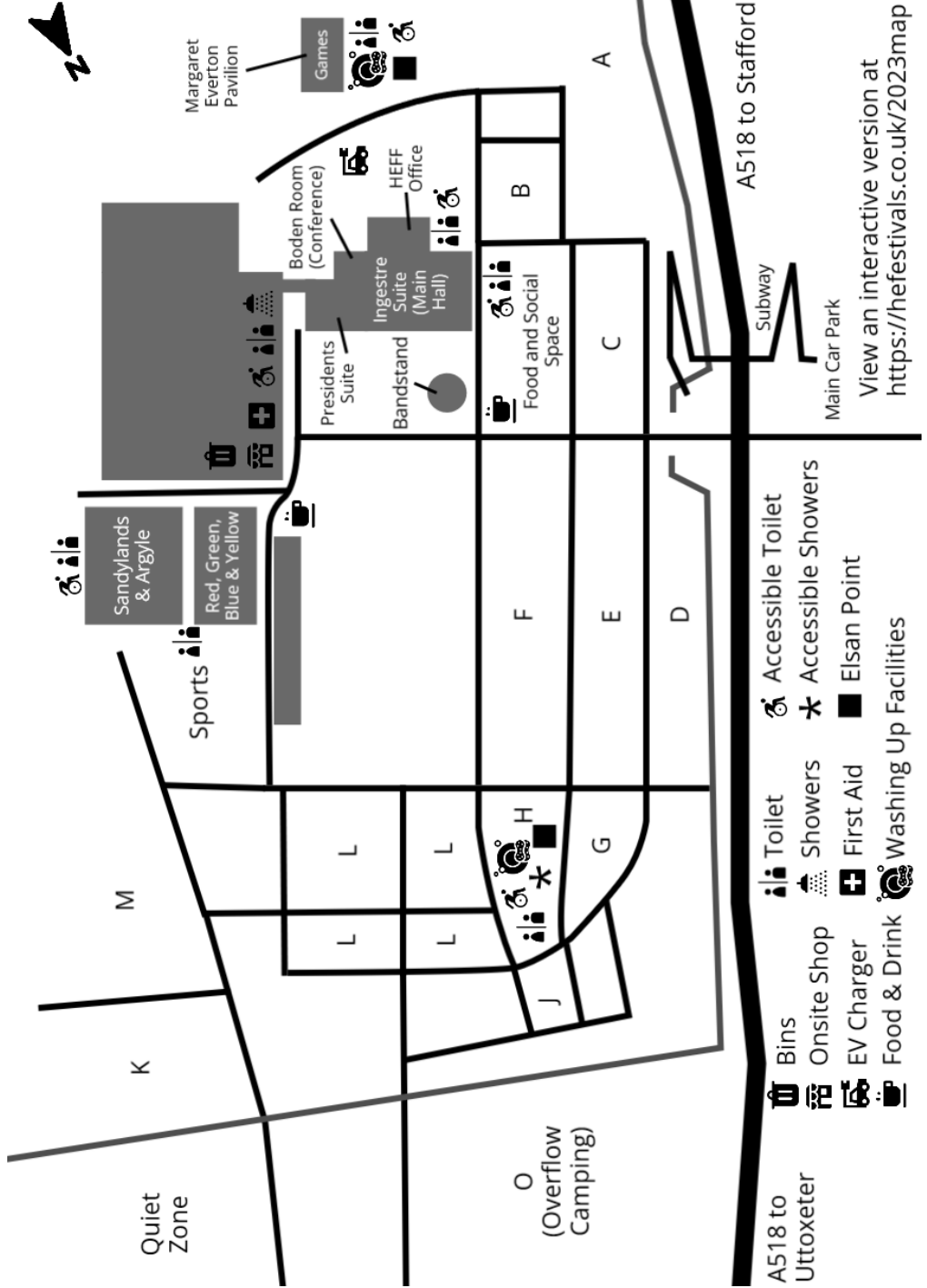
